




#### Focus on **stakeholders** and **governance structures**

- Integrates a governance scheme with the goals and priorities of actors



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



## WS2: Role information in decisions around DGE and HP

- Exploratory survey conducted in (n=797, D-CH) by ZHAW and UniBas
- Explore role of different factors for DGE/HP/ES2050 support
- Results
  - Support for the energy strategy depends significantly on beliefs,
  - Support for a specific technology does less so.

### WS2: Cantonal views on challenges to HP

- Collaboration ETHZ & Uni Basel
- Expert interviews with cantonal officers in charge of HP authorisations
- Qualitative content analysis.

#### First results

- Goal conflicts between BFE and BAFU appears as the most limiting factor for HP
- Economic issues are perceived as conjunctural
- The do not see wider public engagement as necessary. Information is enough
- Increasing discussions with operators about maintenance and safety costs.
- Cantons have little to no resources to plan for HP







### **Upcomming work**

- Completion of ongoing tasks
- Integration of results across the work streams
  - Integrating risk governance scheme with existing practices
  - Use survey on DGE legal aspect to inform public engagement schemes in case studies
  - Use expert interviews to inform about relevance of information predictive models
